5. **Cancellation Policy:** We require a 72-hour cancellation notice. Anything less than 72 hours will be invoiced a cancellation fee of \$75. All holiday deposits and reservations are non-refundable. Please note, you pay for the reservation that you book. We cannot adjust invoices for early pick up/late drop off.

6. **Medication Policy:** Medications will be administered in accordance with the labeling provided with the medication. All medications should be delivered in the original container with correct dosage instructions. Anything in addition to the normal diet and treats (pills, supplements, insulin, etc.) is considered medication. We will adhere to the plan that you and your vet have agreed upon.

<p>7. Food and Treats Policy: We ask that you bring your own pet food in order to maintain a healthy GI tract, as abrupt food changes often result in diarrhea and vomiting. All food and treats must be sealed in a Ziploc bag or Tupperware container according to the NC Department of Agriculture. Please write any special feeding or treat instructions on our intake form prior to drop off. Be sure to include information about food sensitivities, allergies or digestion concerns. If your dog has special feeding instructions or refrigerated food needs, please provide a detailed instruction sheet. Should your dog require special bowls or slow feeders, you are welcome to bring one from home. If your dog runs out of food, our “house food” is a salmon and sweet potato formula dry kibble. A \$1 charge per cup will be added to your final bill. Food, water, urination, defecation is monitored and documented while staying at Dog Tales Day Camp and Boarding, LLC. If you are a long term boarder and need us to purchase fresh food while you travel, please let us know. We are happy to accommodate.</p>	Initial _____
<p>8. Bedding and Toys Policy: You may bring up to 3 toys/bones that your dog can have in his/her nighttime kennel. Please no rawhides, pig ears or bully sticks as they can splinter. Biscuits, jerky treats, greenies and dentastix are our recommended treats. We will gladly wash and re-pack any bedding and toys you bring for your dog’s stay.
